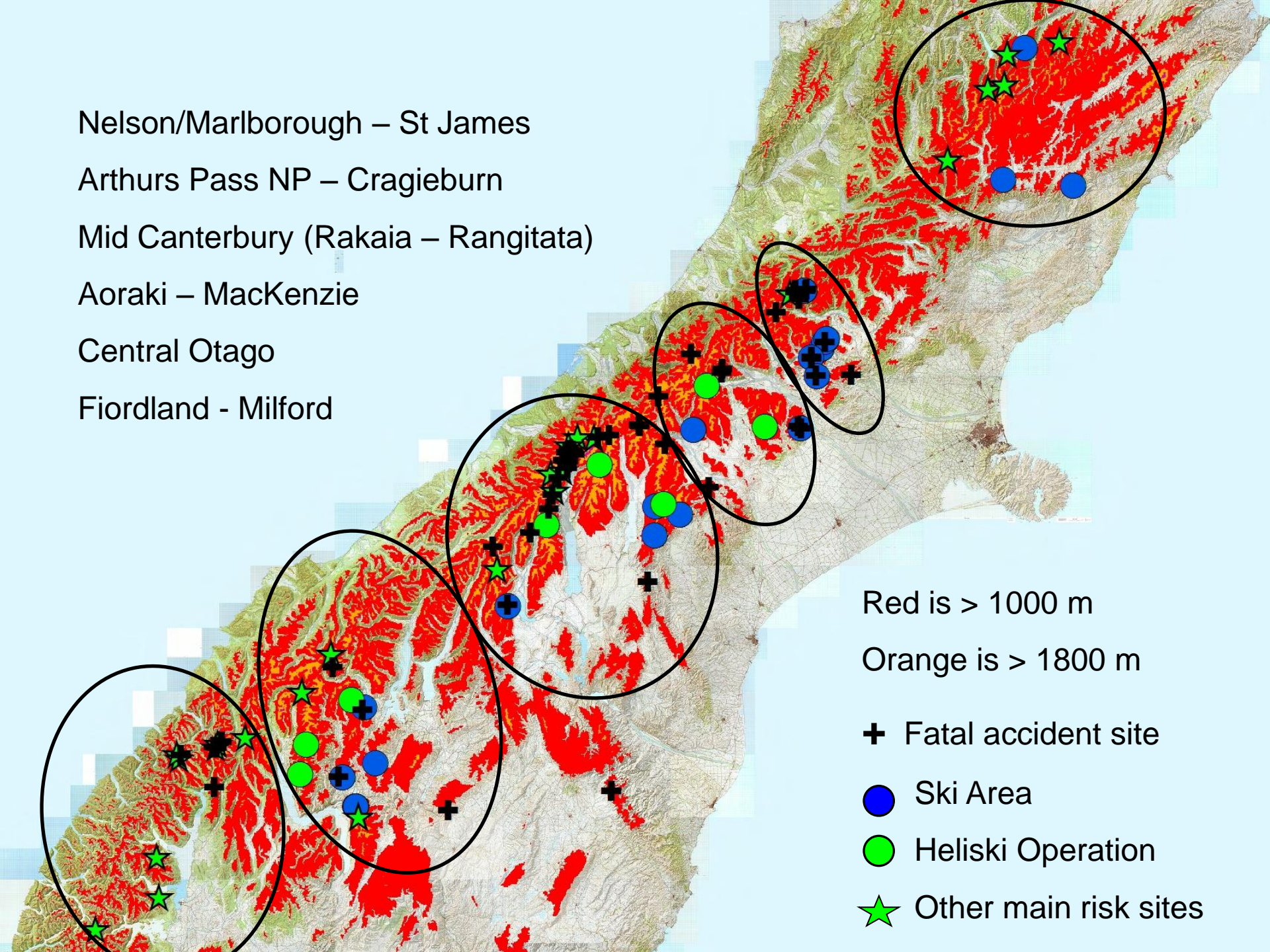

# Scenarios that we need to be prepared for

- Annually we can expect
  - 20 to 30 incidents per annum
  - 4 to 10 responses<sup>+</sup> nationally for 1 to 4
    - climbers
    - out of bounds boarders/skiers
    - heliskiers
    - ski patrollers
    - ski tourers
    - ski area users
    - hunters / trampers

+ = means needed help from outside of the involved group

# Every 3 to 5 years one or more of the following

- Entire heliski party
- Major ski area incident
- Outdoor education/training group, large group of climbers, trampers or skiers
- Large group of walkers on a track near a road end
- Milford road bus
